



JPPF Registry Resources:

Victims and Human Trafficking – Discussion Group

Introduction:

Having completed the anti-trafficking assignment, the discussion group provides opportunity for participants to demonstrate their understanding about victims and human trafficking and discuss and share their ideas for how to identify and support victims of human trafficking.

To support the workshop, we have created a simple powerpoint with suggestions for questions and activities to set the scene and guide further discussion. The powerpoint outlines a simple process and structure for the discussion group to follow.

We suggest that the intent and outcome of the discussion group is to support an action plan to identify and record cases with victims of human trafficking and identify the support that victims require and what resources you have available or are needed.
